Timor Leste

- Gained independence in 2002
- During the struggle for independence most infrastructure destroyed, (1999)
- 95% of schools were destroyed in 1999
- 53% of its population is under the age of 18

Timor Leste

- 37% of its population lives below the poverty line
- 50% of its population is illiterate
- 40% of the population is malnourished.
- Life expectancy at birth is 62.5 years.
